Sling and Rigging Hardware Inspection - 16 Hours - \$1,295

Sling and Rigging Hardware Inspection features classroom instruction and hands on inspection exercises. Synthetic, wire rope and chain slings, as well as rigging hardware (eyebolts, swivel hoist rings, hooks, shackles, turnbuckles and wire rope clips) are examined. Sling inspectors are also trained in the comparative advantages and limitations of sling and rigging hardware types. Sling identification (tagging), proof testing, repair, inspection systems, techniques, removal from service criteria from an ASME, DOL-OSHA, industry association and manufacturer's perspective, and recordkeeping are also covered. Damage identification with an emphasis on cause and corrective action to mitigate damage is an integral part of the instruction. Participants will be tested and receive a certificate of achievement issued by Lift-It.

Sling and Rigging * - 16 Hours - \$1,195

Sling & Rigging (16 Hours) consists of classroom instruction in basic to intermediate rigging activities and addresses two primary areas of information: sling use and inspection. The training also features a second day of hands on activities and team rigging exercises. Sling use on a generic level, topics include: sling designs and components on a generic level, with an emphasis upon proper application. Load weight, sling angle, tension and center of gravity calculations for symmetrical loads are presented in an interactive format. Rigging practices, sling protection and environmental considerations are also presented. Sling inspection is simplified as systems, techniques and removal from service criteria are explored. Participants are trained to perform the frequent (pre-use) inspection with a perspective that rigging is either acceptable or must be removed from service and not used for any purpose. Teams from different industries are supervised as load weight and center of gravity calculations as well as load control and handling exercises are performed. Participants are tested and receive a certificate issued by LEEA.

Train-the-Trainer: Professional Development Program * - 32 Hours - \$3,695

Sling & Rigging (16 hour) is a required prerequisite for Train the Trainer and is included in the price. The course provides an overview of the necessary elements to successfully develop and communicate a lesson plan which transfers knowledge. Retention of lessons learned, aversion to risky behavior and behavior modification resulting in the application of proper practices and techniques is the goal of all safety training. Train-the-Trainer will enable safety professionals to successfully communicate an enhanced message on any subject and is much more than a repetition of the sling and rigging training content. Topics include: enabling and terminal objectives, outline development and presentation style and methodology. Candidate presentations are recorded and critiqued. Participants also receive an Inspector Trainer Kit valued at \$ 1,200.00. Lift-It Train-the-Trainer is where trainers learn HOW to train. Participants receive a certificate issued by LEEA.

NCCCO Rigger Level 1 & Level 2 Certification Preparatory Training- 32 Hours - \$3,295

NCCCO Rigger Level 1 & Level 2 Certification Preparatory Training prepares students for the successful completion of Level 1 & Level 2 Rigger certification testing. Students will participate in classroom instruction and several hands-on workshops for: slings, rigging, hardware, sling tension, angles, center of gravity calculation, sling protection, knot tying and an overview of signalperson responsibilities. Students will examine sling hitch applications and perform load weight distribution and tension calculations for non-symmetrical loads. Participants will also learn methods of drifting and rotating loads. A practice test is administered and includes discussion and review of test answers and course materials. Students will not only be prepared for third party testing, but more importantly, be introduced to the knowledge necessary for the successful performance of Level 1 & 2 Rigger duties. Written exams are administered by NCCCO For NCCCO Rigger Level 1 and Rigger Level 2 Certification. Participants can also complete the NCCCO written exam at an approved Computer Based Testing (CBT) Center within 12 months of training. Practical exams for Rigger Levels 1 and 2 are administered by Lift-It consultants.
